PAST PODIUMS (WR = World Record)

All split times are unofficial. Where possible, the most accurate times are given. These are a mixture of transponder times and those taken from video analysis. Not shown are the 4x100m anchor times from 2015 (Bolt 8.65 etc), as these were triggered by a transponder and stopped by photo-finish. In 2014/2015, the first two legs of the 4x400m were effectively timed manually with a signal as each baton holder crossed the mid-point of the changeover zone in their lane. These have been expressed in tenths throughout, and verified by video where possible. In 2017, the 4x400m splits originally published were determined to be questionable and are not repeated here.
