


New seating category - Pair Seats with Tables available across all sessions

Following updates to the stadium layout, WCH Tokyo 25 is pleased to introduce a new seating category: Pair Seats with Tables. These premium seats will be available for all sessions, including those that had previously sold out.

Located centrally in the third-tier main stand, this new seating option offers a panoramic view of the Japan National Stadium. Designed with both comfort and convenience in mind, each pair of seats includes a dedicated table and occupies the space of three standard seats, providing additional room for spectators to enjoy the championships in a more relaxed setting.

This new category is available exclusively via the official WCH Tokyo 25 ticketing website.








Image: Pair Seats with Tables







Please note:

- All tickets are reserved seating.
- Seats are selected at the time of purchase.
- Pair Seats with Tables are available exclusively via the WCH Tokyo 25 official ticketing website.
- Tickets are sold in sets of two (one table with two seats), and two tickets will be issued per purchase.
- This seat category is not eligible for resale via the official resale platform.
- A handling fee of ¥550 per ticket will apply.
- Wheelchair-accessible seating is not available in this category.

Preventing the unauthorised resale of tickets



WCH Tokyo 25 tickets may only be purchased through authorised sales channels designated by the Local Organising Committee and World Athletics.

Please note that no refunds will be issued in the event that a ticket holder can no longer attend. However, the official ticket resale service will be available, allowing tickets to be safely and fairly transferred at face value to another fan. Please note that tickets purchased through any unauthorised channels will be deemed invalid and will not grant entry to the venue under any circumstances.

We kindly ask fans who are unable to attend to wait until the official resale service launches before attempting to transfer their tickets. To protect the integrity of the event and ensure fair access for all

















supporters, we ask for your cooperation in helping us prevent unauthorised resales by not selling or buying from unofficial channels.
